



2009 LIVE CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING & DISPOSAL

Recycle your live Christmas tree through several community composting and chipping programs. Alternatively, area trash haulers can also remove your tree at the curb for disposal with your regular trash. Please remove all decorations before recycling or disposing of your tree.

Recycling Options

City of Hamilton – Curbside collection for Christmas trees will be the first two weeks in January. Trees will be chipped and mulched. To schedule a pick up, call 785-7580 or visit www.hamilton-city.org for more details.

City of Fairfield – Waterworks Park on Groh Lane will be accepting trees from December 27 - January 9. Trees will be chipped to produce mulch for the city's parks. Resident may also keep mulch for use around their house if they bring their tree on January 9 from 8AM-12PM. Call 867-5348 or visit www.fairfield-city.org for more information.

City of Monroe - Every Friday from January 2 – February 1, the city of Monroe will offer curbside pick up of trees for Monroe residents. The trees will be recycled as mulch. Call 727-8953 for more information.

City of Oxford – Residents may leave trees at the curb from December 14 - January 19. The city will pick the trees up on a daily basis for composting. The winter yard waste collection program is also underway. Yard waste is collected during the first full week of each month on refuse pick-up day, from 8AM-12PM. This schedule will continue through February 2010. The city also offers a drop off location for yard waste on the first Saturday of the month at the city garage (945 Collins Run Rd.) from 9AM - 1PM. (There is no drop off service available in February, service resumes in March). Call 523-8412 or visit www.cityofoxford.org for more information.

West Chester – Drop off trees near the tennis courts at Keehner Park at 7211 Barrett Road through January 15. The trees will be chipped for composting. Call 759-7301 for more information.

Other disposal and recycling options

Middletown and Trenton - Residents may leave trees at the curb for pick up by Rumpke as part of their regular trash collection. Call (513) 425-1860 for more information.

Rumpke customers in Butler County can leave trees at the curb for pick up with trash. Call Rumpke at 742-2900 to see if your tree is considered a "large" item and needs to be scheduled for a special pick up in your area.

CSI customers should call for a \$10 ticket for tree collection. Contact CSI at 771-4200.

Mulch Plus - 2864 Cincinnati Dayton Road near Middletown/Monroe will accept trees for composting from Butler County residents, Monday - Friday from 8AM - 5PM. Call 513-423-8723 for details.
